## REPORT OF THE XXI MEETING OF THE PERMANENT EXPERT GROUP FOR NAVIGATION (PEG NAV)

#### I. ATTENDANCE

The Permanent Expert Group for Navigation (PEG NAV) held its XXI Meeting from September 19 to September 20, 2018. Representatives of the following countries took part in its work: Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Serbia and Slovenia. List of participants is in Annex 1 to this Report.

#### IV. ADOPTED RECOMANDATIONS AND CONCLUSIONS

#### Ad. 1.

The PEG NAV adopted the provisional agenda prepared by the Secretariat (Doc. Nr.: 2-18-2/1-2-PEG NAV).

#### Ad. 2.

The Secretariat delivered and presented the text of the Draft Decision on the "Rules for the Sava River navigation personnel" (Doc.Nr.: 2-18-2/2-2-PEG NAV).

The PEG NAV discussed the above-mentioned document and thereof, adopted following conclusions:

- Representatives of Serbia confirmed their previous point of view that it was necessary
  to split the document into two separate ones (first Rules on Minimum Requirements
  for the Issuance of the Boatmaster's licenses, and the second one Rules on minimum
  manning requirements),
- In general, throughout the text, the term "plutajuće postrojenje" is replaced by the term "tehničko plovilo"
- Article 1.02, paragraph 2, item e) shall be placed in square brackets. As to the definition of the term "sezonska plovidba", it is necessary to discuss the proposal to delete item e) at the next meeting,

- In Article 1.03, paragraph 1, item 21 is amended as follows: "Brodski dnevnik predstavlja brodsku knjigu u koju se unosi službena evidencija putovanja (plovidbe) plovnog objekta i njegove posade",
- In Article 1.04 paragraph 3 is deleted,
- In Article 1.05 paragraph 2 is deleted,
- In Article 1.07 clause "Rijeka Kupa: 5-0" is deleted,
- In Article 1.07, in clause "Rijeka Vrbas: 5-0" number 5 is changed to 3,
- Put the rest of this article in square brackets. The representatives of Republic of Croatia will consider the justification for the proclamation of the listed river sections as the sectors with special risks,
- In Article 1.08 paragraph 3 is deleted,
- Articles from 2.03 to 2.08 should be aligned as far as possible with the provisions of the Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council on the recognition of professional qualifications in inland navigation and repealing Council Directive 91/672/EEC and 96/50/EC,
- Whole Article 2.06 should be placed in a square bracket. By the next PEG NAV meeting, the representatives of the States will provide the Secretariat with the total number of qualifications certificates issued for Boatmaster B in their respective countries for the previous 3 years and will discuss deletion of this Article at the next meeting of PEG NAV,
- In Article 2.10, paragraph 1 is deleted. In paragraph 5, the phrase "kvalificirani član posade palube" shall be placed in a square brackets. At the next PEG NAV meeting, it will be discussed the new formulation of the term concerned, in the sense that it should be replaced with "minimalno u svojstvu kormilara",
- Article 2.12 shall be reworded in such a way, so as to enable the issuance of particular qualifications for all the sections with special risks in all member states,
- In Article 2.14 paragraph 3 is deleted,
- In Article 2.17, paragraph 1 is amended as follows: "Stranke su dužne osigurati da se ispiti iz članka 2.16 stavka 1. točke a) ovih Pravila organiziraju u njihovoj nadležnosti. One osiguravaju i da te ispite provode ispitivači kvalificirani za procjenu stručnosti te odgovarajućeg znanja i vještina iz članka 2.16 ovih Pravila., a najmanje 1 od ispitivača mora posjedovati svjedodžbu o osposobljenosti za koju se polaže ispit.",
- The Secretariat will prepare new text of the Draft Decision on the Rules for crew members in the Sava River Basin in accordance with the conclusions of the meeting and present it at the next PEG NAV meeting.

#### Ad. 3.

The Secretariat presented the Draft Decision on the Manual for the radiotelephone service in the Sava river basin (Doc. Nr.: 2-18-2/3-2-PEG NAV).

The PEG NAV re-considered and discussed the above-mentioned document and thereof, adopted following conclusions:

- Update the data from the Annex 2 of Regional Part of this manual,
- In Table 3 of the Regional Part of this manual, correct the kilometers of the sections of the jurisdiction of Port Master Offices as follows:

#### Ad.6.

The Secretariat delivered and presented Report on realization of the Annual Plan for the marking and maintenance of the Sava River waterway and its navigable tributaries for the year of 2017 (Doc. Nr.: 2-18-2/4-2-PEG NAV).

The PEG NAV considered and discussed the above-mentioned documents and, thereof made the following conclusion:

• PEG NAV members accepted presented document and it will be delivered to the Sava Commission for adoption.

#### Ad.7.

The Secretariat delivered draft Amendments to the Decision 15/14 on the Rules for the Waterway Marking in the Sava River Basin as well as consolidated text (Doc. Nr.: 2-18-2/5-2-PEG NAV).

The PEG NAV considered and discussed the above-mentioned documents and, thereof made the following conclusion:

- For the marks D.1, D.1c and D.1d, add the phrase "black band" behind the label for the outer band thickness 1.0 (cm), as well as the phrase "white band" behind the label for the inner band thickness 2.5 (cm),
- For the Auxiliary signs in the Section II, add the phrase "black band" behind the label for the outer band thickness,
- Formulation for further explanation in the title of the A.5 "on the side of the waterway on which the sign is placed" is deleted. The Secretariat will prepare a proposal to introduce that additional explanation for signs in the Navigation Rules for the next PEG NAV meeting,
- Sketches for floating signs 1.F and 2.F will be added as proposed in Ad. 8,
- PEG NAV members accepted presented document along with concluded amendments and it will be delivered to the Sava Commission for adoption.

#### Ad. 8.

The Secretariat delivered and presented the Proposal for definition of dimensions of floating signs 1.F and 2.F (Doc. Nr.: 2-18-2/6-2-PEG NAV).

The PEG NAV considered and discussed the document concerned and accepted the proposal for their inclusion in Rules for the Waterway Marking in the Sava River Basin.

#### Ad.9.

The Secretariat presented the text for discussion on the topic Detailed Parameters for Waterway Classification on the Sava River – Proposal for further activities (Amendments of certain parameters) (Doc. Nr.: 2-18-2/7-2-PEG NAV).

After the discussion, the Secretariat gave up on the proposed amendments.

The Secretariat will prepare simplified version of Detailed Parameters for Waterway Classification and deliver it to PEG NAV for consideration. After that, the final version of the document will be published on the ISRBC website.

#### Ad.10.

The Secretariat presented Work Plan of the ISRBC and Programme of work for PEG NAV for the FY 2018 (Doc. Nr.: 2-18-2/8-2-PEG NAV).

The members of the PEG NAV took note on the above-mentioned Document without any remark.

#### **Ad.11**

The Secretariat presented the Review of available statistical data on the transshipment of goods and passengers in ports and harbors on the Sava River and its navigable tributaries (Doc. Nr.: 2-18-2/9-2-PEG NAV).

The PEG NAV took note of the document concerned and there was no remark to that regard.

#### Ad.12

The Secretariat presented Forms on harmonized administrative processes in the Sava River navigation (Doc. Nr.: 2-18-2/10-2-PEG NAV).

The PEG NAV considered and discussed the above-mentioned documents and, thereof made the following conclusions:

- Insert the term "svjedodžba o sposobnosti za plovidbu" in all documents behind the phrase "brodska svjedodžba",
- PEG NAV proposes the Sava Commission to recommend the use of mentioned forms for registering the arrival/departure of the ship to the national authorities.

#### Ad.13

Under the Section Other Businesses, PEG NAV proposed that the Secretariat to commence the preparation of a Radar operation manual.

#### Ad.14

The PEG NAV adopted the Report of the twenty first Meeting based on a draft prepared by the Secretariat.
