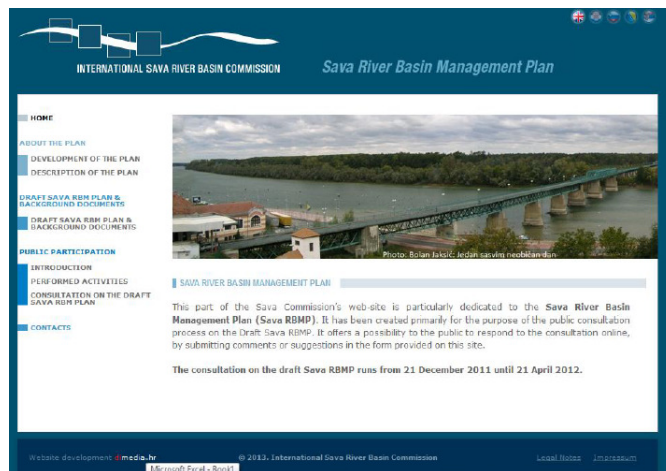
PP main categories

Public participation activities undertaken during preparation of the Sava RBM Plan can be summarized into three main categories:

- 1. Providing information to general public**
- 2. Consultation activities**
- 3. Active involvement of stakeholders**

Providing information to general public

- **Internet based activities:** Info on all phases of the SRBMP development through the **ISRBC official website**
- **Publications:** Information through **different publications** (i.e. SavaNewsFlash), brochures and leaflets (SRBA summary)
- **Presentations:** on development of the Sava RBMP at events organized by ISRBC and of stakeholder groups (e.g. ICPDR, Zelena Akcija, REC, Nature Park Lonjsko Polje, etc



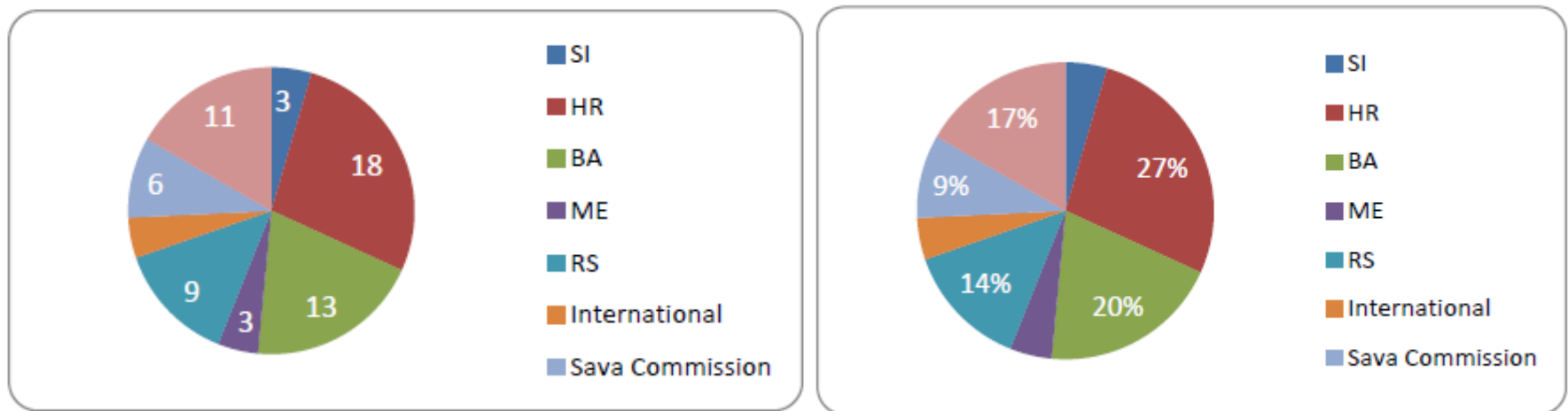

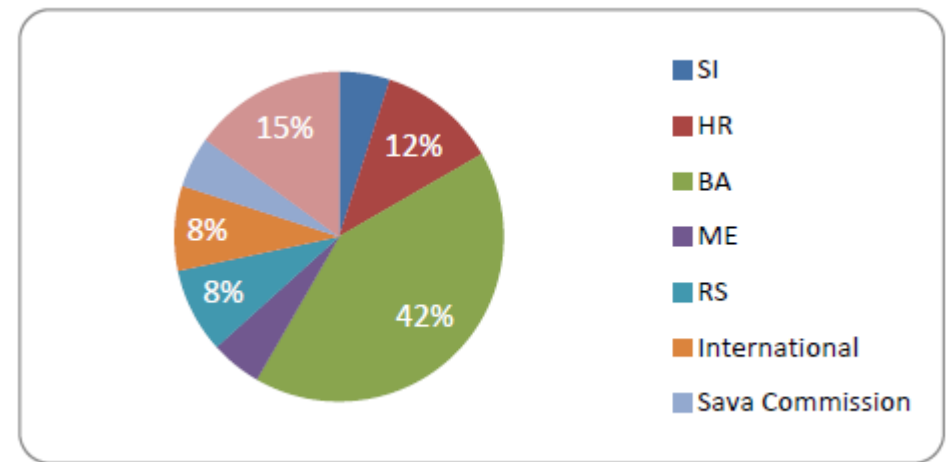
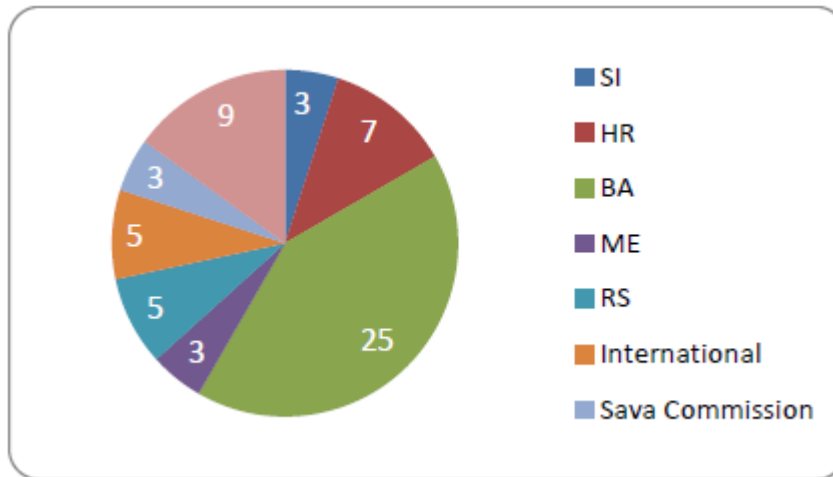

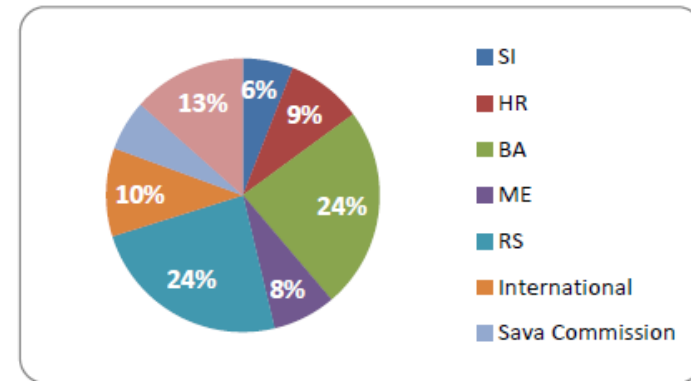
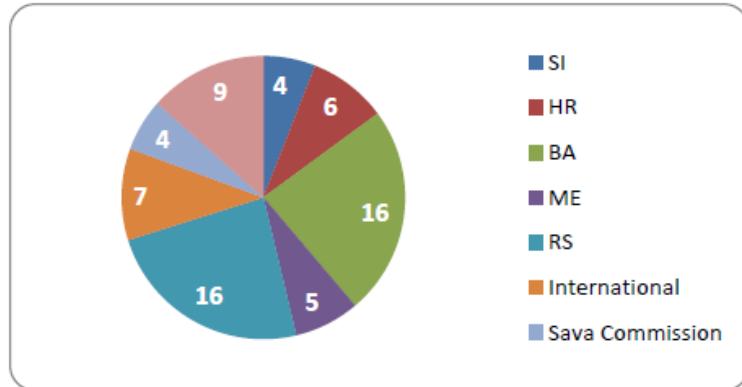
2. *Workshop on the Programme of Measures (PoM)* (Sarajevo, June 28-30, 2011)



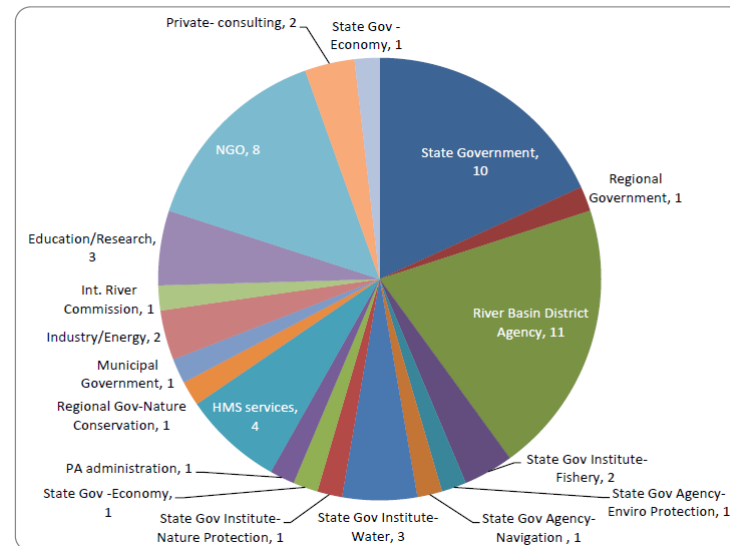
Number and distribution of participants at the PoM workshop (60 participants)

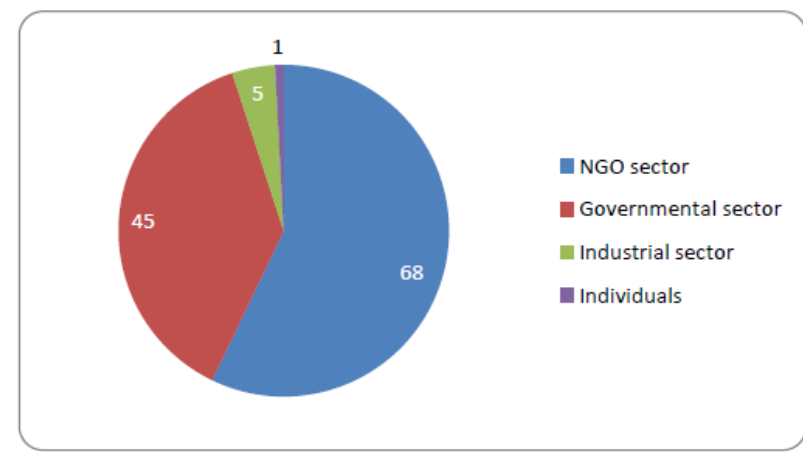
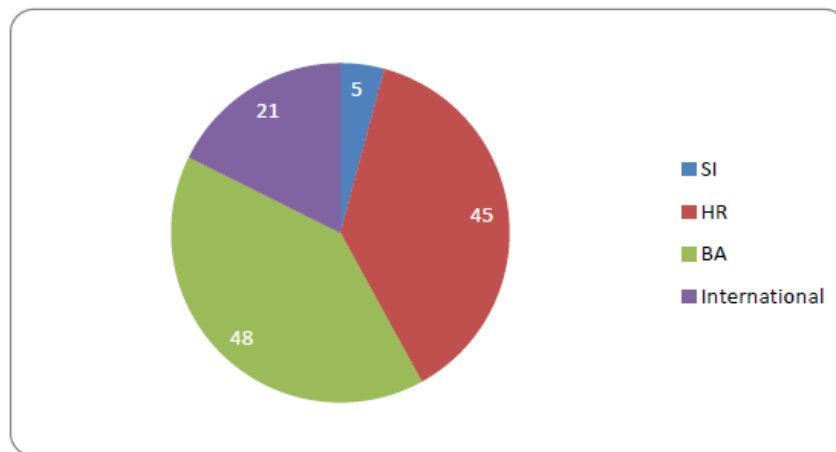

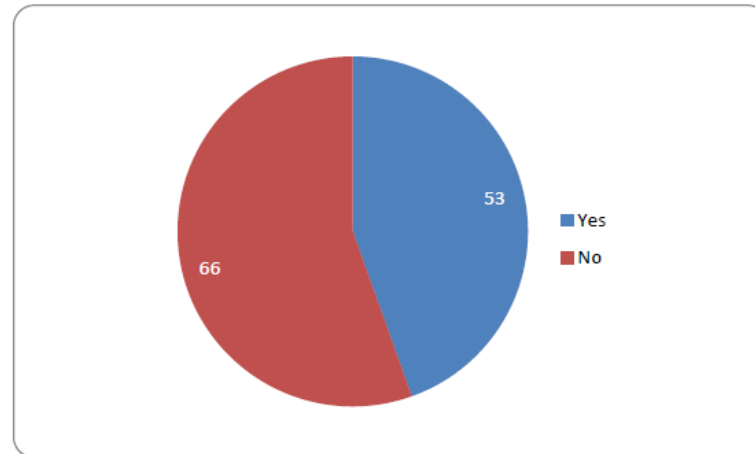
- **Draft SRBMP web-based consultation (21 December 2011 - 21 April 2012)**

- 53 comments accepted
- 66 comments not accepted
- Out of 53 justified comments, for 44 comments corrections/enhancements in the text of the Sava RBMP made.

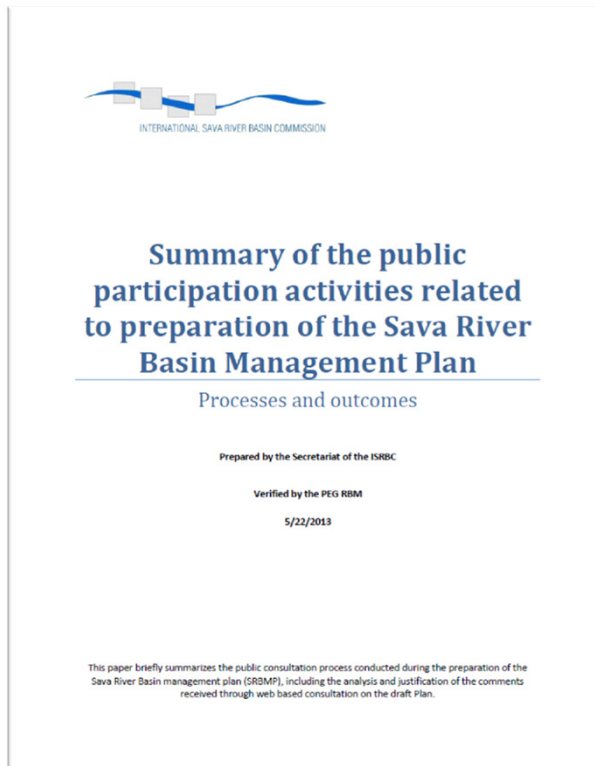
Active involvement of stakeholders

- A major stakeholders / stakeholder groups have had an opportunity to actively participate in this process, as well as in all other activities of the ISRBC, ***by gaining the observer status***. This opportunity is well-utilized by organizations already holding this status to actively participate at the meetings of the ISRBC and its PEG RBM (WWF, Zelena Akcija...)
