



PEG RBM

- summary of activities performed since the previous session of the ISRBC -

In accordance with its Program of work, the PEG RBM held the 8th meeting on June 26-27, 2007. The meeting took place in Zagreb, at the premises of the Sava Commission.

The main issues of the meeting were:

1. Continuation of work on the Sava RB Analysis Report

Water quality chapter

- It is asserted that no upgrade of the chapter is provided
- New deadline for submission of available data for the chapter is set to the 1st of August

Water quantity issues

- Serbia presented its work on the chapter. Other countries haven't provided any results so far. It is expected that it will be done on the next PEG meeting in September.

Mapping needs for the Sava RBA report

- The Secretariat presented all collected data compiled in an ARC GIS project. Source of GIS data are Sava CARDS project, ICPDR and EEA.
 - Countries' presentation of available basic data in accordance to the initial list of maps
- No information on available data is provided by the countries. (Serbia provided the information as well as some data in GIS form immediately after the meeting.)

Other SRBA activities

- Status of hydrology report for the SRBA – The Secretariat informed the Group on the status of the activity and further steps

2. Cooperation and Projects

Sava RBM Plan project proposal

- The Group is briefed on current project status

Sava LIFE/SDC project

- Mr. Erg from the project presented to the Group current activities. No conclusions are made on the cooperation with the project.

The South East Europe (SEE) Programme 2007 – 2013 project proposals

- Short information on nominated projects is provided to the Group. Details in AD. 5.

Preparation of project proposal for UNECE

- The Group is informed on the proposed activities for the UNECE project. The Group agreed on proposal.

3. Protocols

Protocol on sediment management

- The Secretariat presented current status of the preparation of Protocol. The Group supported the idea to establish a task group for preparation of the Protocol.

4. Sava Day activities

- The Group is informed on all activities on occasion of the first celebration of the Sava Day.

The meeting report is drafted but still not accepted by the PEG RBM. No documents for adoption by the Sava Commission.
