

**PEG APC****- summary of activities performed since the previous session of the ISRBC -**

In accordance with its Program of work, the PEG APC held its 7<sup>th</sup> meeting on June 12<sup>th</sup> 2008 in Zagreb.

The main issues which were discussed on the meeting were:

○ AEWS system

*After the presentation of the report of the unannounced AEWS test which was held in April 2008, the PEG APC adopted following conclusions:*

- *According to the results of the announced (November 2007) and unannounced tests it has been demonstrated that the AEWS system works according to expectations. In B&H and Serbia PIAC centers do not operate 24 hours. Sava Commission should remind the Parties of the FASRB to establish the 24 hours Accident Prevention and Control System.*

○ Development of projects:

*PEG APC discussed about the draft ToR for development of International Contingency plan in the Sava River Basin and suggested minor modification of the document.*

*PEG APC was informed that the provisions of ToR for International Contingency Plan were part of the project titled Water Pollution Contingency Management System for Sava River Basin-WACOSS which was proposed to be funded within the SEE Programme*

*PEG APC was informed that provisions of the Joint Sava Survey- preparatory documents were included into the project titled Joint Sava Survey 2009 - Activities on the establishment of reference conditions and assessment of environmental status for the Sava River and selected tributaries- JSS2009. The project was proposed to be funded within the SEE Programme.*

*PEG APC discussed about DBAM model and took note of presentation of flood forecasting system on Mura river and adopted following conclusions:*

- *DBAM is very rough model especially in the part concerning Sava. It should be revised within WACOSS project.*
- *The Secretariat should prepare ToR for collection and revision of necessary data to develop similar model for Sava River and its main tributaries.*

○ Development of protocols:

*The PEG APC took note on presentation of Protocol of Sediment Management and adopted following conclusion:.*

- *The members will send main questions to the Secretariat until June 19<sup>th</sup>.*

○ Other issues:

- *The secretariat presented events celebrating Sava Day and basic information of development of LIFE project.*
