



### PEG FP

#### - summary of activities performed since the previous session of the ISRBC -

In accordance with its Program of work, the PEG FP held the two meetings in the reporting period:

- 9<sup>th</sup> meeting on February 05-06, 2009;
- 10<sup>th</sup> meeting on March 24, 2009.

Both meetings took place in Zagreb at the premises of the Sava Commission.

The main accomplishments of the 9<sup>th</sup> meeting were:

- The final draft version of the **Protocol on Flood Protection** has been agreed upon. The document will be distributed to the PEG FP and Ah LEG and open for remarks 7 days and thereafter submitted to the Sava Commission for final adoption;
- The first draft of the Table of Contents for *Program for Development of the Flood Risk Management Plan in the Sava River Basin* has been prepared and accepted as the initial version
- **GIS flood indicative maps** for the Sava River Basin are prepared by the Secretariat on the bases of data provided by the countries
- Hydrology report for the SRBA has been reviewed. The PEG FP supported preparation of **a new common hydrology study for the Sava River Basin**, based on new, more accurate and harmonised data on the basin-wide level.
- PEG FP recommendation: Taking into account the time required for putting the Protocol in force (approximately 2 years) and in order to continue the activities already started, **the PEG FP suggests to the Sava Commission to prepare a joint Statement** (or any other appropriate form) to be adopted at the meeting of the Parties (as also suggested by the ad hoc LG);

The main issues considered and accomplishments of the 10<sup>th</sup> meeting were:

- Realization of the Work Plan of the ISRBC for 2008\_FP issues
  - Position paper – drafted. The PEG FP considers appropriate to prepare final version after the consultation meeting on the Protocol on flood protection
  - Country assessment reports: RS and HR accepted, BA- needs final refinement and translation in English, SI-not submitted;
  - Flood Management Chapter of the SRB Analysis Report shall be prepared by the Secretariat based on the country assesment reports and data already collected and analysed;
  - other PEG FP activities planned for FY08 are considered finished
- Work plan of the ISRBC\_FP issues and PEG FP programme for the FY09 are accepted by the Group;
- Priority projects of the Sava Commission – the list has been upgraded by the Group

All issues not mentioned in this summary, as well all details of the emphasized issues, can be reviewed in the attached reports from the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> meeting.

Report from the 8<sup>th</sup> PEG FP meeting, approved by the Group on its 9<sup>th</sup> meeting, is also submitted as the session document.
