PEG APC reviewed the report of the 10<sup>th</sup> PEG APC meeting. All tasks which have been discussed on the previous meeting have been finished or were part of 11<sup>th</sup> PEG APC meeting.

The PEG APC took note about the meeting with the institutions responsible for civil and accident protection held in Belgrade (RS) on September 11<sup>th</sup>, 2009 and, thereof, adopted following conclusion:

- 2.1 The meeting has showed that Serbia has already achieved a certain progress concerning establishment of PIAC operating 24/7. According to the representative from RS the relevant institutions will be asked to nominate responsible officials.
- 2.2 On September 24<sup>th</sup>, 2009, the exercise on emergency preparedness was performed on Danube river according to Helsinki Convention. The representative of Serbia will deliver the report of the exercise until the next PEG APC meeting.
- 2.3 The Secretariat should contact the representative of the Sava Commission to organize a meeting with relevant institutions in BA.

The PEG APC took note about the proposal of the new AEWS test and, thereof, adopted following conclusion:

- 2.4 Step 11 to announce End of the test is not necessary. End of Alert (Step 9) is end of test. The revised programme fo test is enclosed.
- 2.5 According to the AEWSMokrice09 programme the test will be performed in the first week of December 2009.

The PEG APC took note on report from the Conference on Territorial Cooperation in South East Europe which was held in October 14-15, 2009 in Sarajevo and the presentation of new project proposal on WACOSS project delivered by Primož Banovec (University of Ljubljana) and thereof adopted following conclusions:

3.1 Project WACOSS will be submitted to the second call for project proposals within TCP SEE.

The PEG APC took note on the presentation on the project Reducing Transboundary Pollution Risks within the Drina River Basin delivered by Jovanka Ignjatović (REC) and thereof adopted following conclusions:

3.2 Data collected within Drina project should be linked with SavaGIS.

3.3 Within the Drina project a system should be establish to exchange and update data periodically. It should be operational after finishing the project as well.

3.4 Data inventory about traffic and urban runoff should be established as well.

3.5 Some inventory data about pressures for BA are available in the project for Kolubara River. The project team should contact Mr. Slobodan Čubrilo and Mrs. Amra Ibrahimpašić to get information about existing data for BA.

3.6 Amra Ibrahimpašić (BA) and Dušan Dobričić (RS) will participate the Inventory Task Group and AEWS WG of the Drina Project. Traveling and accommodation costs will be covered by the project.

3.7 It is recommended that representatives from HR will participate the AEWS WG as well. The Drina project representative should contact Hrvatske vode.

3.8 It is recommended to established regional center with the communication unit in Drina River Basin. The location will be proposed on the next meeting of the Drina Committee.

3.9 Within Drina project capacity building and training for members of PIACs from BA and RS will be organized.
