In the afternoon, female entrepreneurs and tourism experts from all five countries of the Sava basin will discuss (in-person and online) the obstacles that women face in the tourism sector, explore opportunities for cross-border networking and leadership, and propose the establishment of an Association of Female Entrepreneurs in Tourism of the Sava River Basin.
