IV. ADOPTED RECOMANDATIONS AND CONCLUSIONS

Ad. 1.

The PEG NAV adopted the provisional agenda prepared by the Secretariat (Doc. Nr.: 2-14-2/1-2-PEG NAV).

Ad. 2.

The Secretariat delivered and presented the text of the Amendments to the Decision 30/07 on the Navigation Rules in the Sava River Basin (Doc. Nr.: 2-14-2/2-2-PEG NAV).

The PEG NAV re-considered and discussed the above-mentioned document and thereof, adopted following conclusions:

- In the Article 12.02, paragraph 4 is amended as follows "After the performed surveillance, the competent authority that carried out surveillance will make the report in accordance with the national law, which shall contain the information specified in Annex 11. A copy of the report will be delivered to the party concerned."
- Title of the Annex 11 is amended as follows:

THE CONTENT OF THE RIVER SURVEILLANCE FORM

The data to be included in the report from the Article 12.02, paragraph 4,

- In the item 2 of the Annex 11 replace "inspection" with "surveillance",
- In the item 5 of the Annex 11 replace ", vessel register " with "ship certificate",
- In the item 6 of the Annex add " or official number",
- In the item 7 of the Annex 11 delete the phrase in the brackets,
- After the item 7 of the Annex 11 add new item 8 "number of passengers permitted",
- In the item 15 of the Annex 11 replace ,, taken " with ,,ordered",

• In the item 16 of the Annex 11 replace "inspection "with "surveillance",

Ad. 3.

The Secretariat presented the latest results of the work of the Joint Expert Group for modernization of the rules on the crew qualifications within the European Commission. The PEG NAV adopted the following conclusion:

 PEG NAV will follow the work, which takes place within the EU, on amendments to the regulations on the requirements for issuance of boatmaster's licenses and will actively participate in the work through the representative of the Secretariat.

Ad.4

The Secretariat notified the PEG NAV members of the status of the document "Manual for the Navigation on the Sava River". PEG NAV (Doc. Nr: 2-14-2/5-2-PEG NAV) and adopted the following conclusion:

- Secretariat will, immediately upon receiving the text, submit it to the members of the PEG NAV,
- It is recommended that the Secretariat organize public presentations of the Manual in the member states of the Sava Commission.

Ad.5.

The Secretariat presented the latest information on the status of the Rehabilitation and development of transport and navigation on the Sava River waterway. Members of PEG NAV stressed the need of timely and coordinated follow-up activities on the Project development.

Ad. 6.

The Secretariat delivered and presented Report on realization of the Marking Plan of the Sava River waterway (Doc. Nr.: 2-14-2/6-2-PEG NAV) and Report on realization of the fairway maintenance on the Sava River for 2013 (Doc. Nr.: 2-14-2/7-2-PEG NAV).

The PEG NAV considered and discussed the above-mentioned documents and, thereof made the following conclusion:

- The PEG NAV adopted Report on realization of the Marking Plan and Report on realization of the fairway maintenance on the Sava River for 2013.
- The Secretariat will submit those reports to the Sava Commission for discussion.

Ad.7.

The Secretariat delivered and presented the text of Draft amendments to the Decision 13/10 on Rules for definition of winter ports and winter shelters in the Sava River Basin (Doc. Nr.: 2-14-2/8-2-PEG NAV).

The PEG NAV considered the above-mentioned document and thereof, adopted following conclusions:

- PEG NAV adopted the document concerned,
- The Secretariat will submit this document to the Sava Commission for adoption.

Ad.8.

The Secretariat delivered and presented Draft proposal for the marking of winter ports and winter shelters in the Sava River Basin (Doc. Nr.: 2-14-2/9-2-PEG NAV).

The PEG NAV considered the above-mentioned document and adopted it along with the following amendments:

- Delete the item 1 and leave only the item 2 as an example for the marking of winter shelters.
- Delete the item 4 and leave only the item 3 as an example for the marking of winter ports, where marks on the left side of the scheme (upstream entrance into the winter port) should be removed with the downstream entrance marked only, while those marks should be given the right character codes, i.e. replace E.27.1 with E.25 and E.26.1,
- The above proposal will be included as an addition to the Rules for waterway
 marking in the Sava River basin, as well as to the Rules for definition of winter
 ports and winter shelters in the Sava River Basin, which will be submitted to the
 Sava Commission for adoption.

Ad.9

The Secretariat delivered and presented the proposal for the initial network extension of the Indicator of river kilometers for the Sava river and its navigable tributaries (Doc. Nr.: 2-14-2/10-2-PEG NAV). The members of the PEG NAV took note on the above-mentioned information and adopted the following conclusion:

- PEG NAV member from Slovenia will check the possibility of delivery of the relevant data on the Sava River in Slovenia and provide the information to the Secretariat.
- PEG NAV members from Serbia, Croatia and Slovenia will collect the data on the bridges that are not included in the previous editions of the Indicator and the Album of bridges, as well as bridges at the section upstream from Sisak, for which the extension of the Indicator is to be done.

Ad. 10

The Secretariat presented Work Plan of the ISRBC and Programme of work for PEG NAV for the FY 20124 (Doc. Nr.: 2-14-2/11-2-PEG NAV).

The members of the PEG NAV took note on the above-mentioned Document without any remark.
